

If you don't want to draw pictures, you can use the blank pages to write more of your story.


You are getting a badge for this, so we have to have some rules.


1. Write any story you want to. If you can think of one that goes along with the Summer Learning theme of Fairytales, Fantasy, and Mythology that would be great.

  - A. Preschoolers = 1/2 page
  - B. PreK—2nd grade = 1 page
  - C. 3rd—4th grade = 1 1/2 pages
  - D. 5th-6th grade = 2 pages
  - E. 7th grade & up = 2 1/2 pages




