

The City of Mineral Wells is accepting applications for positions on the Mineral Wells Housing Authority, the Board of Adjustment/Building and Standards Commission, and the Palo Pinto County Water District #1 Board.

Mineral Wells Housing Authority: Oversees the Shady Oak Circle projects and Section 8 Housing. Appointed by the City Council, but not a department of the City. Consists of five members that serve two-year terms. The Housing Authority normally meets the 4th Thursday of every month.

Board of Adjustment/Building and Standards Commission: Renders interpretation of zoning ordinance; considers special exceptions to land uses and variances to building controls set by zoning ordinance. Also administers the City's condemnation/demolition program. Must be a City resident and qualified elector. Five members, four alternates, two year terms. Not an advisory Board, decisions are final. Normally meets on third Thursday each month at 9:00 a.m.

Palo Pinto County Municipal Water District No. 1 Board of Directors: Water District owns water rights to Palo Pinto Lake and the Water Treatment Plant and facilities operated by the City. The Water District provides water to Mineral Wells and her environs. Water district residency required. Five-member Board, two year terms. Meets monthly on last Friday.
