

## MINERAL WELLS SWIM TEAM

**New Swimmers:** *This is a competitive swimming team.*

Your coaches this summer will be Meagan Waldrum and Hannah Price-Davis. They will give you contact details.

You will need to tryout in order to be on the team. Ages 10 & under must be able to swim one length of the pool (25 yards), without stopping or holding onto wall, demonstrating a fundamental knowledge of the front crawl (freestyle) and/or breast stroke.

Ages 11 & up must be able to swim one lap (50 yards), without stopping or holding onto wall, and demonstrating a fundamental knowledge of the front crawl (freestyle) and breast stroke.

**Registration fee:** \$80.00

### **General Information:**

The swim season runs through July 9, 2022. The first four circuit meets that the team attends are a preparation for the Regional Swim Meet.

### **Other Costs:**

Team suits will be available for purchase before the circuit meets begin. The suit/shirt coordinator will have the sizing kit and other information, hopefully by first practice date. A price has not yet been finalized with a vendor, but as soon as we have that information it will be sent out to all registered swimmers.

You are not required to purchase a suit but the team looks more uniform and orderly if they are all attired in the same suits.

T-shirts will be provided for registered swimmers, and parents/family may purchase one as well. Again, working on pricing of t-shirts.

Racing goggles are highly recommended for better swimming.
