

NOTICE TO WATER CUSTOMERS

April 1, 2023

As the drought condition advance throughout the State of Texas and in a continued effort to better prepare us for potential severe drought conditions, **effective April 1, 2023**, the City of Mineral Wells will initiate STAGE II Water Use Restriction. STAGE II of the City's Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plan is described as follows:

STAGE II – Moderate Water Shortage Conditions

- No outside water use permitted.
- The only outside water use exception is for animals.
- Construction projects shall use reuse water.
- Businesses requiring water as a basic function of the business, such as nurseries, commercial car washes, laundromats, high-pressure water cleaning services, etc., will obtain written permission from the City Manager for intended water use.
- Commercial uses not listed will be controlled to the extent directed by the City Manager.

The water use restrictions will remain in effect until further notice. Violations may result in a fine up to \$500 per occurrence and/or discontinuation of water service.
