

MINERAL WELLS SWIM TEAM

New Swimmers: *This is a competitive swimming team.*

Your coaches this summer will be Hannah Price-Davi and Ashlynn Davis. They will give you contact details.

You will need to tryout in order to be on the team. Ages 10 & under must be able to swim one length of the pool (25 yards), without stopping or holding onto the wall, demonstrating a fundamental knowledge of the front crawl (freestyle) and/or breaststroke.

Ages 11 & up must be able to swim one lap (50 yards), without stopping or holding onto the wall, and demonstrating a fundamental knowledge of the front crawl (freestyle) and breaststroke.

Registration fee: \$100.00 (\$95.00 for each additional family member).

General Information:

The swim season runs through July 8, 2023. The first four circuit meets that the team attends are preparation for the Regional Swim Meet.

Other Costs:

Team suits will be available for purchase before the circuit meets begin. The suit/shirt coordinator will have the sizing kit and other information, hopefully by the first practice date. The price has not yet been finalized with a vendor, but as soon as we have that information it will be sent out to all registered swimmers.

You are not required to purchase a suit, but the team looks more uniform and orderly if they are all attired in the same suits.

T-shirts will be provided for registered swimmers, and parents/family may purchase one as well. Again, working on pricing of t-shirts.

Racing goggles are highly recommended for better swimming.

Ages 11 & up: 7:20 a.m. – 8:45 a.m.

Ages 10 & under: 8:50 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.

No practice on Memorial Day (May 29, 2023)

Parents are not allowed on deck at any time during practice. If you need to talk to the coach, please ask a lifeguard to notify the coach of your desire to speak with them. Children may be dropped off, but a parent or guardian must be back in time to pick the child up when their practice is over.

We will be hosting a circuit meet on June 10, 2023. All parents/guardians are needed to help with the meet in order for it to be successful. More duty information will be available closer to meet date.
